

SACRAMENTAL AND PARISH INFORMATION

New Members

Welcome to Saint Francis Parish. Please call the Parish Center Office in order to register in our parish, or stop in during office hours or on the weekend after all Masses. One needs to be a member of our parish three months in order to receive a certificate of eligibility. Please notify the office if you change your address or move away.

Religious Education (PREP)

All children of the parish should be receiving religious instruction through our parish school or through our Parish Religious Education Program which has been combined with the Cathedral of Saint Catharine of Siena. Please contact the Coordinator of Religious Education, Donna Sciacca at 610-432-7655 or by email at prep@cathedral-church.org

Marriage

We look forward to celebrating God's gift of love in the sacrament of marriage for any registered and practicing parishioner. Diocesan policy states that contact should be made one year, but no later than six months, prior to the proposed date of marriage in order to begin pre-nuptial instructions. Call the Parish Center Office for further information.

Baptisms

Baptisms are held for our registered (at least three months) and practicing parishioners normally the first Sunday of the month immediately after the 10:30 Mass. Parents are to register for a Baptismal Preparation Class held normally on the Wednesday before each baptism in the Parish Center. At least one Godparent must be a practicing Catholic for the valid reception of baptism. That person must also be able to receive a certificate of eligibility from their Catholic parish. A Non-Catholic Christian is permitted to act as a witness. Parents should begin to make arrangements for a baptism during pregnancy.

Godparents & Confirmation Sponsors Info

You must be at least 16 years of age, have received the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation, must be known to attend Mass regularly and, if married, the marriage must be recognized by the church. These requirements are the universal law of the church. All requests for 'Letters of Good Standing' are to be made well in advance to the Parish Office.

Ministry to the Sick

Please notify the Parish Center Office when a parishioner is in the hospital or home and would like to receive communion or the anointing of the sick. Visits can also be made to those parishioners who are homebound and would like to receive confession and communion.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA)

We welcome and support all whose faith journey brings them to seek full communion with the Catholic Church. Please call the Parish Center Office for further information.

Saint John Vianney Regional School

We encourage all our parents to consider sending their children to our parish school, Saint John Vianney Regional School. Our school is located at 210 North 18th Street in Allentown. Please contact our school principal at 610-435-8981 to register your child for a faith based, middle-states accredited, Catholic education.

Allentown Central Catholic High School

We encourage our high school students to consider attending our local Catholic high school - Allentown Central Catholic. Please contact the Director of Admissions, at (610) 437-4601 for more information.

longer held onsite. We have joined with the Program at the Cathedral of St. Catharine of Siena.



PREP VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!

We couldn't do it without you!

Volunteers are crucial to the Religious Education program for the Cathedral of St. Catharine of Siena and St. Francis of Assisi Parishes. Volunteering with children is a truly joyful experience!



Weekly classes are on Sundays, 9:45 AM - 11:15 AM, from mid-Sept. to mid-May.

Qualifications: *You have a willing heart, ready to share your time and talents.* You are a practicing Catholic over the age of 18, and have received all your sacraments. *All volunteers are required to obtain Local, State, and Federal child clearances as outlined by the Diocese of Allentown. Assistance in this process will be provided by our DRE.* No experience is necessary; training and support will be provided.

Classroom Co-Catechist: Share the responsibilities of planning and co-teaching with one of our Catechists. *Those who volunteer as Co-Catechist are eligible for a 50% discount on tuition fees for their children.*

Classroom Aide: Assist the Catechist as needed. Duties may include helping children find textbook chapter and Bible readings, assist a struggling student to read or understand the assignment, pass out and assist with lesson crafts/handouts. Escort children to the bathroom.

Substitute Catechist: Fill in for an absentee catechist.

PREP Office Volunteer: Monitor the school entrance door (lock & unlock at designated times), answer the bell and escort late arrivals to their classrooms. Assist in providing requested materials to catechists, make copies of student handouts, escort children in grades 1-4 to the bathroom upon Catechist request.
